DBC Member Kellie Kinard first traveled to Thailand after the tsunami in 2004. She was part of a two week team from DBC that helped rebuild houses. When all the houses were complete, Kellie joined a ten month team that was remaining in the villages affected by the tsunami. This team supported and nurtured the small church that was planted during the rebuild. They also built a church and community center. The center offered English classes, art and music lessons, and a gathering place for the villagers.

Kellie currently serves with the agency, Compasio, and is leading a mobile medical unit in the town of Mae Sot on the Thai-Burma border. Kellie and her team hope to go in to villages and provide basic medical care, education on sanitary practices and nutrition, and provide immunizations. Long-term, the team hopes to establish a welcoming presence in the villages, build relationships and open doors to the Gospel. They also hope to increase knowledge of disease transmission, the importance of hand washing, increase child immunizations and so much more.

Currently, Compasio has a few safe houses for children who are abused, orphaned or have parents in prison. Their goal is to give these children hope, a future and to introduce them to Jesus Christ as their ultimate Savior.

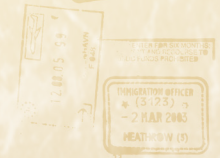
