The mission of Bridge Between Walls is to share the message of Jesus Christ with people of other cultures and religions in Atlanta.

Bridge Between Walls was formed through Dunwoody Baptist Church's partnership with Bayo Oti, a local Nigerian missionary and former practicing Muslim. The ministry focuses on bridging the gap between other religions and Christianity. This is primarily accomplished through one-on-one evangelism that demonstrates the love and grace of Jesus Christ while also providing for the physical and practical needs of individuals and families.

Community Ministry in Clarkston

To reach these communities with the Gospel, Bridge Between Walls has been able to form important partnerships within the community that assist Bayo in being warmly welcomed by its residents. By working alongside these community associations, Bayo is able to reach individuals and families to help meet their physical and spiritual needs through one-on-one relationship building.

Apartment Ministry in Chamblee

Bridge Between Walls ministers to more than 140 Hispanic families in the Huntington Terrace Apartment Complex in Chamblee, where Bayo resides. The ministry provides a variety of practical services to residents, including ESOL classes for children and adults, family counseling, Bible study opportunities, daily after school programming for youth that includes activities, tutoring sessions and Bible lessons. Each week, Bayo visits the families he works with individually to fellowship with them, provide prayer support and offer practical assistance as needed.
