DBC supports two organizations who serve families that are in financial crisis with temporary relief and support in the areas of Dunwoody, Sandy Springs, Chamblee and Doraville.

Benevolence

Community Action Center

CAC is a co-op that is supported by churches, businesses and individuals. It focuses on the prevention of homelessness and the provision of basic needs to individuals and families such as financial assistance, food, clothing, holiday food baskets, Christmas gifts, summer camp and school supplies. Additionally, ESOL and computer classes are available.

Volunteers are needed to conduct client interviews for financial and food assistance; work in the food pantry or thrift shop; counsel clients; teach ESOL.
