

Community Outreach Partner Foster Care Support

Foster Care Support Foundation was started in the founders' garage in 1997 after a realization that there was a tremendous lack of support for our most at-risk children in Georgia.

There are over 13,300 foster children in Georgia and approximately 30% of the cost of raising each foster child will come from the foster parents' pocket. Foster Care Support Foundation, is an all-volunteer community resource dedicated to helping provide clothing, toys and equipment such as cribs, car seats, strollers and high chairs to foster families and foster children in Georgia.

Foster Care Support also partners with Georgia's Department of Family and Children Services for child verification, foster parent recruiting and foster parent training. They hold free training meetings 8 out of 12 months during the year to support the education of foster parents on how to better care for the neglected and abused child in their home and to enable them to meet their required training hours and keep their foster parenting license.
